Item 6 Police Report -There are major problems with young people breaking into cars and a trailer was also stolen. Burglaries are also increasing and items were stolen from Church Street. 25.5.09 & 28.5.09. The public have been asked if they saw anything and cards have been put through doors, answers to come back. In Ramsey this action was taken and they caught the culprits. The main outcome is to let the Police know of any suspicious behaviour as soon as possible. The Police would like to arrange a surgery so the local people can come and talk over the main problems, and also the Police to walk round village and talk to residents. The question of night patrols was raised, and they attend quite regularly, Old Hurst & Woodhurst, but they will take the query back and see if patrols can be increased. Another problem that is happening is thieves are waiting until residents go on holiday and then burgle, but some offenders have been caught and awaiting trial.
