

## A FIND AT WOODHURST.

### Church Vases and Candlesticks in Trousers.

A man named Stokes, of Woodhurst, whilst cutting a hedge in the village of Woodhurst on Tuesday, found an old pair of trousers in the hedge. The legs of the trousers were tied round the bottom, and inside were discovered six brass candlesticks and two vases. He informed the police at St. Ives, who took possession of the articles.

It is considered that the brasses had been where they were found for some time. It will be remembered that candlesticks and vases were stolen from the altar of Warboys Church last August, and those found in the hedge resemble them. They are all in good condition, and have been handed to Supt. G. Wilson (Stanground), who is in charge of inquiries.
