### Woodhurst Rights Of Way

Villagers are reminded that they and their dogs must keep to the public rights of way at all times. Most farmers in the village are participating in environmental schemes that involve leaving conservation strips around the edges of fields, these are **not** public paths but are designed as undisturbed strips that encourage birds and mammals to settle, feed and breed, the success of these strips relies on them being undisturbed by man and beast.

If walking with dogs please ensure that your dog is under close control and keeps to the designated path, this is vital to prevent disturbing ground nesting birds at this critical time in their nesting season and a matter of courtesy to farmers whose crops you or your dog damage if wandering off the path.

The public rights of way within the village are detailed on Ordnance Survey maps and the Cambridgeshire County Council website (search for rights of way).
