## **One Way Traffic for Woodhurst**

A new traffic management scheme will be introduced to the village so that money can be saved on road maintenance. Under the plan both South Street and Church Street will become one way streets. A Highways Agency spokesman explained the change by saying "the new system will halve the number of cars that use the two roads at any one time, meaning that we will only need to resurface half as often as we do now".



## **Traffic Lights**

On Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays, South Street will only be open to traffic entering from West End and Church Street will only be accessible from the East. On other days and at weekends the flow will be reversed so that car tyres don't wear out on one side more than the other. A traffic light system will control access to the two roads
