Thefts In The Village

2017 has seen a significant increase in thefts and break-ins in the village. Following a recent meeting with representatives from the Police comprising one of the investigating officers from the Burglary Team, the Crime Reduction Officer and the local coordinator for Countryside Watch, please find enclosed an insert outlining some hints and tips on reducing risks of thefts. The main thing is to show potential thieves that things have changed in the village and that we as a community are taking action. Please consider the points raised particularly before you go on holiday and report any suspicious vehicles in the village- with number plates, dates and times- to the non-urgent emergency Police number "101" or indeed via Cambs Police website reporting page facility.

Dog Fouling

There has been a noticeable increase in the amount of dog fouling in the village. This is apparent not just around the footpath network and Church Lane but also on verges that householders take the time to maintain. Please do pick up after your dog and deposit bags in the bins provided around the village.

Village Maintenance

The Parish Council have taken over responsibility for the various planters around the village following the folding of Natural Woodhurst. Our maintenance contractors in the village, Joe and Carol Jeakins, have carried out this work for the Council and on your behalf.
