22	<p><b>Village Hall</b> – Cllr Notman informed the meeting that a new bar extension had been built and the toilets have now been signed off for building regulations. Redecorating and new windows would be completed during August.</p>	None
23	<p><b>LHI</b> – Cllr Notman has gaining permission from Huntingdonshire County Council for the installation of 2 poles to hold a speed indicator devise should they be necessary. The buffer zone signs have now be ordered and it is hoped that these works will be carried out over the next few months.</p> <p>Cllr Notman read out an email received from CCllr Criswell - The only thing I have to report is that the Wheatsheaf crossroads project is being put on hold by the new Lib Dem -led Administration pending a review.</p> <p>As you know, preparatory work was due to take place over the summer for a build date this coming winter. It would appear any decision to continue will now to go to Committee in September. If they do try to reverse the previous Administrations' decision all hell will break loose from me and colleagues at HDC. Fingers crossed it won't come to that, but thought you should be aware. Obviously from a road safety perspective, any delay is regrettable.</p> <p>It was agreed that Cllr Notman would proceed with an LHI bid for this year to include a 20mph zone in South Street.</p>	AN
