- **4. FINANCIAL REPORT OF THE PARISH COUNCIL** It has been a mixed year for the Parish Council as we come out of Covid restrictions. The Precept remained low at £6000.00, payments were made from this for:

Village Maintenance £1203.00 while slightly less than last year JJ Garden Maintenance continued to maintain the village appearance with particularly beautiful flower tub displays all year round.

The streetlights were maintained for an ongoing cost of £432.00 per year and powered for £328.51, the increasing energy costs are a concern but Councillors are working hard to secure a good fixed rate for the coming year.

Parish Council meetings and administration were carried out at a cost of £2551.36. Printing of the newsletters and social media that help to keep Parishioners informed of village news and events cost £197.07.

Part of the remaining monies have been put aside for continuing traffic calming measures that are being installed throughout the village.
